MEMORANDUM FOR ALL HOLLOMAN USERS

SUBJECT: Authorized Dining Facility (DFAC) Patrons

1. In order to maintain ACC standards, improve preparation efficiency and most of all, serve active duty Airmen, the following DFAC Patronage Policy will take effect on 1 Oct 2010.

2. In accordance with AFI 34-239, *Food Service Management Program*, Attachments 3 & 9, the following personnel are authorized to utilize the DFAC:

Military Personnel:

- a. Permanent Party Enlisted Personnel on Meal Card (ESM)
- b. Permanent Party Enlisted Personnel receiving BAS
- c. Foreign Government Enlisted Military Personnel
- d. TDY Enlisted Personnel
- e. TDY Officers & TDY DoD Civilians (as indicated on TDY orders)
- f. TDY Officer candidates, USAFA/ROTC Cadets
- g. Commanders (periodic QoL meal inspection)
- h. Officers and DoD Civilians filling first responder roles, i.e.; Fire Department and Security Forces (excluding gate guards).

Civilian Personnel:

- a. Retirees (retiree dependents may attend on weekends, down days, and federal holidays)
- b. Spouse and dependent children of active duty E-1 through E-4 are authorized users.
- c. Dependents of deployed members participating in sponsored programs

3. Exception: due to limited options, the DFAC will be open to all AD and DoD Civilian members while on duty for breakfast and midnight meal periods. Members must be in appropriate uniform and present CAC at time of purchase.

4. The installation commander reserves the right to amend this guidance to include exercises, contingency operations and other special programming.
