SUBJECT: Shifting Sands Dining Facility Dress Code

1. This letter outlines the dress and appearance standards for personnel utilizing the Shifting Sands Dining Facility at Holloman Air Force Base. The standards described below are necessary to maintain health and sanitation standards as well as present a professional image, ensuring good order and discipline.
2. Military uniforms will be worn in accordance with AFI 36-2903, *Dress and Personal Appearance of Air Force Personnel*, or applicable service directives. All civilian attire will be worn in good taste.
3. The following clothing items are prohibited:
 - a. Torn, frayed, sweaty, or excessively soiled athletic apparel and clothing that the facility manager or shift leaders deem unsanitary for customers and/or employees
 - b. Undergarments or pajamas (with the exception of crew/V-neck t-shirts), to include swimsuits or swim trunks
 - c. Clothing with obscene, profane, lewd words or drawings that reflect unlawful, illegal, unconstitutional, or subversive ideas
 - d. Spandex, tights, or shorts/pants that do not cover the buttocks
 - e. Jewelry not in compliance with AFI 36-2903 para 3.5 & 3.6 (i.e. nose rings, etc.)
 - f. Clothing items that expose bare underarms or midriff (i.e. tank tops, tube tops, and/or cut shirts)
 - g. Unauthorized headgear in uniform and/or other head coverings with the exception of food service workers, religious headwear, Security Forces personnel under arms, and persons undergoing medical treatment
4. Individuals failing to comply with these standards will be asked to leave until all requirements are met.
